Summary:

Duties and Responsibilities:

As a Dishwasher in the Stackner you are a vital part of our operations success. You will be responsible for the overall cleanliness of our dishes, flatware's, Pots and Pans, Cook Utensils etc. You will responsible for ensuring all dishes are done during your shift, for leaving a clean and sanitary work station at the close of your shift, and for sweeping and mopping before the end of the night. In this role you will oversee the operation of the Dish Station and must communicate any changes in The Dish Machine's function - malfunctions, water not holding temperature, sprayers not running, etc., communicate when detergents and sanitizers are running low, and communicate and needs or concerns about the station on an as needed basis.

- Clean and Sanitize all dishes, kitchenware, glasses, flatware, pots and pans, utensils, etc. as they come to you
- Maintain a clean work station throughout your shift
- Work positively with all staff members
- Ensure kitchen floor is swept and mopped at the end of each shift
- Ensure that Dish Station is closed down properly at the end of each shift
- Ensuring that the station is reset for the next shift.
