The Food Runner is also responsible for preparation of our Anytime Menu which includes desserts and small bites. Food Runners assists wait staff by clearing the dining room of any dishes and set up of back kitchen stations. We are currently seeking motivated individuals to join our team with the following relatable experience:

- Ability to read and understand food order tickets.
- Check station before, during, and after shift for proper set-up and cleanliness. Maintain condition and cleanliness of work area, walls, equipment and tables.
- Assist with bussing duties when needed.
