Position Summary:

Milwaukee Repertory Theater is accepting applications for a detail and quality-oriented, multitasking Stitcher to join our costume department. The Stitcher assists the Draper and First Hand in the construction of all new costumes and the alteration of stock costumes for each production. The regular workweek for this position is Tuesday – Saturday.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Stitcher position requires a strong working knowledge of costume construction and an ability to sew both manually and with a machine. The Stitcher will also assist with other shop duties including, but not limited to: assisting in fittings, laundering and repairing costumes as needed, as well as attending all shop meetings.

Skills and Qualifications Required:

Ideal candidates will have a keen eye, and the ability to multitask, troubleshoot, and adapt quickly. They must work and communicate well with others while exhibiting good humor under pressure.

Physical Demands:

- Able to work with your hands for long periods of time
- Specific vision abilities required by the job include close vision to discern fine detail

Compensation and Schedule:

This position is full time, seasonal, with benefits and is eligible for overtime. The bulk of the work hours will happen during normal business hours and the duration of the position runs August to April, exact dates TBD. This position pays a weekly salary of \$525. 100% employer paid health insurance for individuals.
