### Position Summary:

Milwaukee Repertory Theater is accepting applications for a quality-oriented, efficient, multitasking Stitcher to join our costume department. The Stitcher assists the draper and First Hand in the construction of all new costumes and the alteration of stock costumes for each production. The Stitcher stitches and finishes all assigned costumes while working as part of a team to keep a clean and safe work area and to produce garments in a timely manner.

### Compensation and Benefits:

This is a full-time, non-exempt, seasonal, Belo position paid a weekly salary of \$600.00 with an exceptional benefits package that includes paid time off and 100% employer paid individual health insurance. The bulk of the work hours will happen during normal business hours and the duration of the position runs October to June, exact dates TBD.

### Major Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- Sew assigned costumes by hand or machine
- Assist in fitting, stitching, or other assigned costume duties
- Maintain and alter costumes as assigned
- Assist in the laundering and repair of costumes throughout the run as needed
- Assist in maintenance of costume inventory
- Maintain a clean and safe work area
- Attend technical rehearsals as assigned
- Attend regular shop meetings
- Participate in educational and outreach events
- Other duties as assigned

### Qualifications:

Ideal candidates will have demonstrated experience in machine and hand sewing techniques. Significant experience in garment construction and the ability to follow precise instructions is necessary. Familiarity with industry standard construction techniques is preferred. Candidates must also work and communicate well with a diverse group of colleagues, all while exhibiting grace and good humor under pressure.
