Specific audition information will consist of two uploaded videos demonstrating the young performer's acting and singing ability. Submissions are due by **Wednesday, September 1**. Those chosen from submitted materials will be notified of a callback the week of September 8.

*A Christmas Carol* rehearses **Tuesdays through Sundays** from **November 2 to November 28** and performs **November 30 – December 24, 2021** at the historic Pabst Theater. Please note that young performers will need to miss school for technical rehearsals and matinee performances.
