Position Summary:

As a Dishwasher in the Stackner Cabaret you are a vital part of the success of our operation. This position oversees the operation of the dish station and is responsible for the overall cleanliness of our dishes, glassware, flatware, pots, pans, cooking utensils, etc. You will be responsible for ensuring all dishes are completed during your shift, leaving a clean and sanitary work station at the close of your shift along with sweeping and mopping at the end of the night. This position also monitors and communicates any changes in the function of the dish machine.

Other major duties and responsibilities include:

- Clean and sanitize all dishes, kitchenware, glasses, flatware, pots and pans, utensils, etc.
- Maintain a clean work station throughout your shift
- Complete all daily tasks assigned
- Train in other areas of the kitchen as needed
- Organize, put away and rotate orders as needed
- General cleaning and maintenance of work areas
- Ensure kitchen floor is swept and mopped at the end of each shift
- Emptying trash and recycling bins
- Ensure that dish station is closed down properly at the end of each shift
- Ensure that the station is reset for the next shift
- Work positively with all staff members
- Assist in clearing the dining room as needed
- Work as part of a team and uphold the standards of the organization at all times

Qualifications:

- Ability to stand for 6 hours at a time and lift up to 50 lbs. unassisted
- Strong communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to multi-task
- Must be able to work independently and as part of a collective team
- Able to work in high pressure situations, all while exhibiting grace and good humor under pressure
- Comfortable taking direction and feedback
- Ability to work quickly while maintaining a high quality of work performed
- Ability to pass a background check in accordance with state and/or federal laws
- Ability to provide proof of fully vaccinated status before first day of work
